## What will be the impact of the EFC Day of Giving?

Stuck in an ever-increasing national housing crisis with fewer and fewer options due to rent increases, overcrowded conditions, or lack of access to affordable financing, many families live with a constant burden of uncertainty, stress, and fear in Canada. That's why local Habitats

partner with working families living with low income to help them build strength, stability, and independence through affordable homeownership.

Habitat homeownership provides families with more than just equity – it instills them with a renewed sense of pride and responsibility. The impact is immediate, and the effects are lasting.

Research has shown that Habitat homeowners are happier, healthier, and more financially stable, which can allow them to return to school, learn a new trade or upgrade their job skills. Meanwhile, their children are more confident and do better in school.

But the benefits of a Habitat home reach far beyond the four walls these families help build. Through reduced reliance on social housing and food banks, better education and employment outcomes, and improved health, every Habitat home built helps create \$175,000 worth of benefits for the local community.
